Use Case	Apply for college
Actor	Low income, minority, first generation student
Basic Flow	• He thinks about his grades, test scores and writing skills • He thinks about where his friends or other people in his class are applying going • He takes into account if his family wants him to go to a certain school or work • He researches local options and what deliverables are required for the application These may include: ○ SAT or ACT scores ○ High school transcript ○ Vaccinations ○ Personal Statement • He schedules a date to take the SAT/ACT and needs to figure out how to prepare for the test. • He finds resources to learn about loan programs, financial aid, and scholarships.
Alternative Flow 1	If he is concerned about not having enough money and resources. ○ Only look for school options that are local so he can remain living at home ○ Apply for loans ○ Figure out student financial aid ○ Scholarships

Alternative Flow 2

- Does he need to help support his family?
- Does he need to work part time while in school?

If he is unsure of the best path or direction to take

- Figure out who to talk to, find someone who might give him direction; family, friends, teachers, school counselors
- Do research online
- Does he have any connections or support?

Alternative Flow 3

If overcoming cultural boundaries/assimilation

- Find confidence or support to cope with internalized oppression, stereotypes, or racism
- Find support in overcoming any language barriers
